Dear Incoming Kindergarten, First, and Second Graders' Family Members:

Below is a list of the suggested school supplies which we will be using for the 2011/2012 school year (some supplies will be shared): Please make sure that your child's supplies are labeled with their first and last name and their class.

- 10 marble notebooks - Please label them as follows:

Social Studies
Response Journal,
Homework
ELA
Writing
Science
Specials

Two extras- Just in case!

- 3 packs of **sharpened** pencils (**Please be sure to sharpen them before school starts!** **1st and 2nd Grade Only**)
- 5 plastic twin-pocket folders (paper folders get ripped very easily).
- 2 glue sticks (one to be left at home, one brought to school to be shared)
- 2 boxes of crayons (one to be left at home, one brought to school to be shared)
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- **Girls:** 1 package multicolored construction paper (shared material)
- **Boys:** 1 container of Clorox disinfecting wipes
- **Girls:** 1 box of Gallon sized zip-lock bags
- **Boys:** 1 box of sandwich size zip-lock bags
- 1 change of clothing for bathroom accidents (socks and underwear included). Please place in a plastic bag and label with your child's name. **Kindergarten and 1st Grade Only**
- 1 durable white board/ dry erase board with lines on the back(maximum size 8 ½ by 11)
- 1 pack of black dry erase marker (fine tip only)
- 1 plastic pencil case **1st and 2nd Grade Only**
- 1 bottle of Elmer's white glue
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pack small post-it
- 1 small binder (1 1/2 inch rings)
- 1 pack of wet wipes
- Backpack (that will hold a standard folder)
- 1 hand sanitizer
- 1 box colored pencils
- Sneakers (for Gym)
- 1 Smock (or old, oversized t-shirt) for Art
- 1 Small plastic storage(to keep students supplies safe and secure) **1st and 2nd Grade Only**

Please note that replacement of supplies may be asked for throughout the year.

Be sure that students have pencils, crayons, scissors, and glue at home for use on projects/homework throughout the year.
