- 6 glue sticks

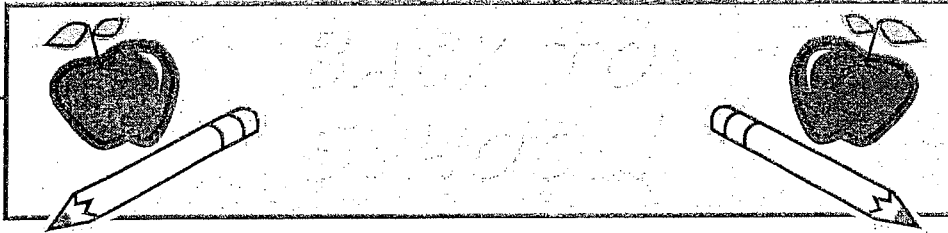

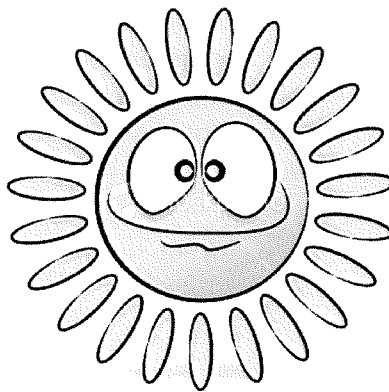
