In Kindergarten we share all school supply items and these are provided. You are welcome to donate extra crayons, markers, scissors, etc. as extra's are always appreciated!!

At home your child should have crayons, scissors glue, pencils and markers to complete their Kindergarten homework.

The following are consumable items that we use often. Please help by donating the following items for our classroom use.

- 1 bottle of school glue for Art class.
- 1- box of Saltine Crackers
- 1-2 boxes of Ritz crackers or other snack crackers
- 1 -2 large box of Kleenex tissues
- 1 package (4-6 oz. Size) paper cups
- 1-2 rolls of paper towels
- 1- container "Clorox" type antibacterial cleaning wipes
- 1-2 packages of EXPO brand white board markers, low-odor, black or mixed colors, broad tip.
- small or large package of inexpensive white 6" paper plates
- 1 box of sandwich Ziploc baggies

First Grade Supply List

School Supply List – Miss DeHaan and Mrs. Krosschell 2nd Grade

**** All pencils, erasers, tissues, and wipes will be used by the entire class. Students are able to use these materials whenever they need to. Please bring these to school in a bag labeled with your child's name. I will hand out the materials to each child. Thank you! J**

**** Please feel free to bring your supplies to school on the day of the Open House. This will help lessen the load on the first day of school!! J**

- 2 packs of #2 pencils (Ticonderoga brand are best!!)
- 4 packages of Pencil Top Erasers
- 2 packs of crayons (24 pack or larger, Crayola are best.)
- 1 LARGE glue stick
- 1 Standard size pencil box
- 1 one inch binder with a clear plastic cover that you can insert a piece of paper into.
- 2 PLAIN (NO characters/decorations please) heavy duty two pocket folders without middle paper holders. Don't worry about labeling them; I will take care of that.
- 2 PLAIN (NO characters/decorations please) one subject spiral bound notebooks. Don't worry about labeling them; I will take care of that.
- 1 pair of school scissors. (Fiskars are best.)
- 3 boxes of Kleenex tissues
- 5 packages of baby wipes
- 1 container of Lysol-type sanitizing wipes
- 1 Backpack (No wheels please, they do not fit well in the lockers.)
- 2 rolls of paper towel
- Additional markers/colored pencils are optional. We do not use these very often.
- 1 extra pack of pencils for the art teacher (Mrs. Roys says THANK YOU!)



Mr. Caudill's Supply List

3rd grade

- 1 pack of block erasers (for Art)
- Hand held pencil sharpener at least one)
- 16 pack crayons
- 1 glue stick
- 2 paper/plastic folders (2 pocket) with your child's name written on them; one for homework, and one for their desk
- 1 pair school scissors
- 4 pack of dry erase markers and old sock or eraser
- 1 container of baby wipes
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 rolls of paper towels

If you are not able to purchase any of the above items for your child, I will have extra supplies.





Mrs. Peterson's Supply List 3rd Grade

- 1 pack of block erasers (for Art)
- 24 pack crayons (Crayola are best)

- 4 paper folders (2 pocket) with your child's name written on them: one for homework, one for their desk, one for data we collect, and a spare.
- 1 pair school scissors (Fiskars are best)
- 4 Dry erase markers and old sock or eraser.
- 2 packs of **wide-ruled** lined paper
- (3) 1-subject notebooks
- (1) 1 inch binder for data/reading binder
- (1) 2 inch binder for planner and homework folder
- 2 containers of baby wipes or refill packages
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 container of hand sanitizer



4th Grade Supply List

Required:

One folder to be used for homework only- must have two pockets- please label: TO DO and TURN IN J

- 5 packs of #2 pencils
- 1 pack of colored pencils (for art room)
- Two 70 page, wide rule spiral notebooks
- One 1" binder, with a plastic cover on the front where a piece of paper can be inserted
- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 3 rolls paper towels
- 5-6 containers of Lysol or Clorox disinfecting wipes
- Dry erase markers
- 2 red pens and 2 blue pens
- 2-3 packs of notebook paper

Recommended, not required:

Small **fabric** pencil case to fit inside desk

- Scissors
- Glue

Large binders and trapper keepers are not needed!

Please bring classroom and personal supplies to the orientation on August 23 or August 24. This will allow you to organize your desk before the first day of school!



Fifth Grade Supply List

The following is a list of supplies your student will need for the 2011-2012 school year. Please make sure your student has all the supplies prior to the first day of school.

Individual items:

- A backpack **without wheels** (These are the kind that fit **best** into shared 5th grade lockers.)
- 10 two-pocket folders without middle paper holder (folders with 3 holes would be ideal)
- A Trapper Keeper or binder that zips or velcros closed with a 2-inch ring that will be able to accommodate the folders purchased (please check to make sure folders fit inside binder)
- 3 one-subject spiral notebooks (wide-ruled)
- A zipper pouch for pencils to go in the binder (boxes are too big for the desks)
- 2 highlighters

8 dry-erase markers

Classroom items: These items will be donated to the classroom

- 1 pack of 10 pencils (we'd prefer students **not** have mechanical pencils)
- 1 pack of pencil top erasers
- 1 pack of markers
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 2 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper

- 3 rolls of paper towel
- 1 box plastic spoons
- 1 box plastic forks
