Here is a supply list that your 3rd grader needs for this year. Students can bring in their supplies in the first few days of school but I would appreciate it if all students have their supplies by: Friday, September 7th. Some supplies will be considered our community supplies, which will be used as needed in the classroom.

Please make sure that your child has his/her name or initials on ALL of their STUDENT supplies in order to keep their materials separate from other students.
