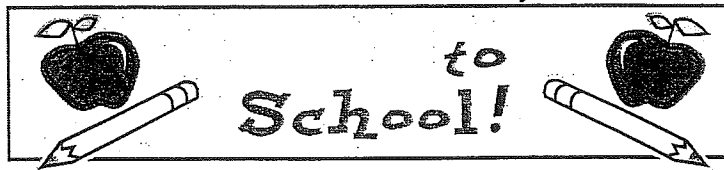

Supplies

** Graphing calculators, although costly, can be an invaluable tool for your child and are required in most high schools. Also, graphing calculators are permitted on the calculator portions of several standardized tests and college entrance exams such as the MEAP, SAT, and ACT. The more comfortable a student is with their calculator, the more effective it will be as a tool. Both scientific and graphing calculators are available at most general stores (Office Max, Office Depot, and Staples). If you are interested in buying a graphing calculator, we recommend the TI-84. Watch for those back – to – school sales!
