Bridge Books or alternative Academic book	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to all students • Other academic workbooks can be completed in place of the Bridge Book • 100% completed bridge book (or alternative) is due the first Friday of the 2018-2019 school year (bridge book - does not include "bonus section") • Students who completed the entire book can participate in a dress down day (date TBD) and will be included in a raffle
Book Reports	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to all students • Students read 3 books (at least one must be 1 non-fiction) within their Lexile range (use Lexile.com to assist in the choosing of books) • Packets/activities must be completed for each chosen book • All paperwork can be found on EA's website • All 3 packets are turned in the first Friday of the 2018-2019 school year • Students who complete all 3 packets can participate in a dress down day (date TBD) and will be included in a raffle
Educational Summer Camps	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to all students • Students attend an educational camp (Kumon, Sylvan, EMU, etc.) • Parents are responsible for all costs of the camp. • All students who submit proof of an approved camp will be able to participate in a dress down day (date TBD) and will be included in a raffle.
Other Community Resources/Family Outings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open to all students • A list of Community Resources is on EA's website and attached • Parents are responsible for any costs • Students attend one of the outing locations (or a similar one) and complete a response page. A ticket stub or receipt must be attached to the response page.
