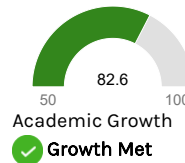

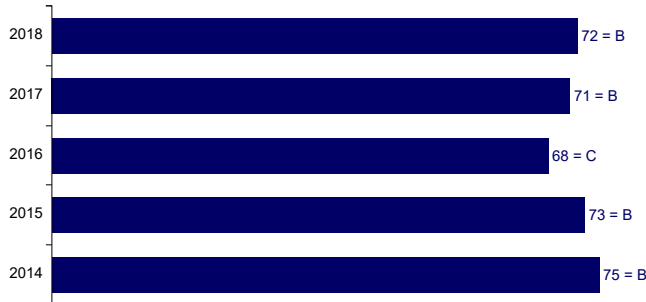

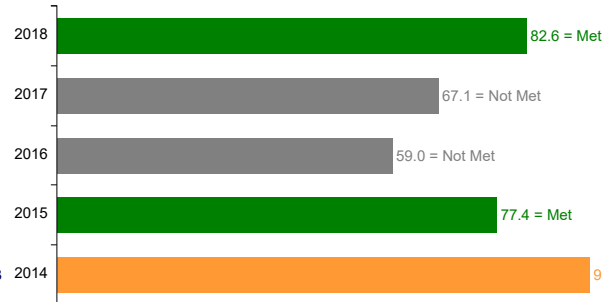

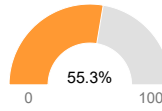

Incoming Student Readiness

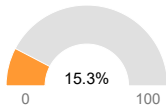


55.3% of the students entering 6th Grade across the school are proficient.

Percentage Economically Disadvantaged

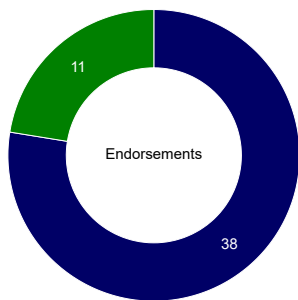

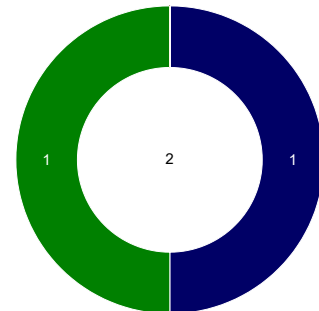

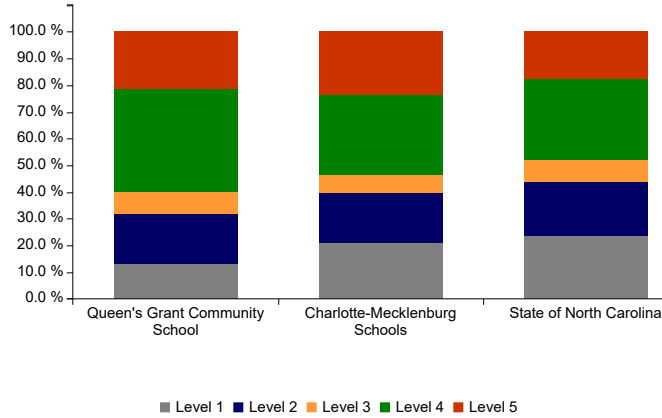

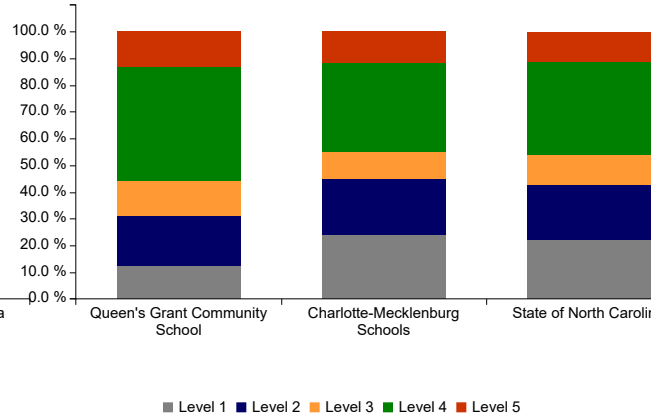

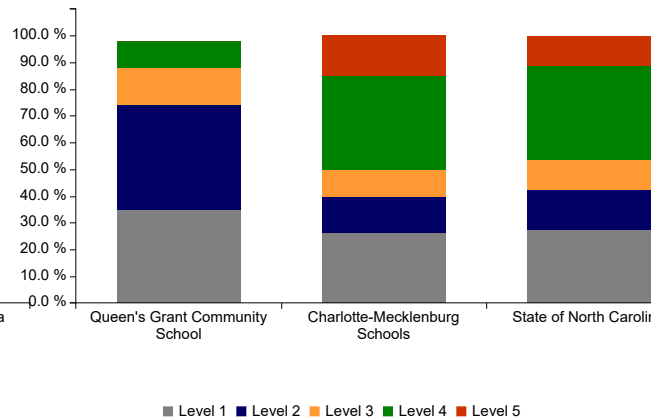

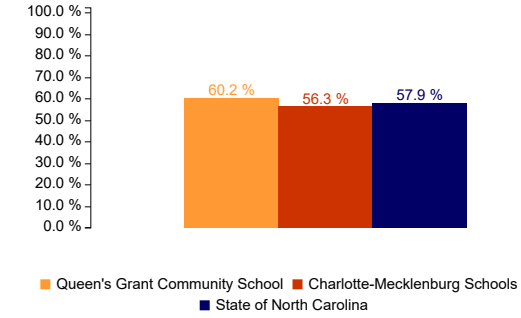
4 Year Graduation Rate

Percent graduating within four years at Queen's Grant Commu



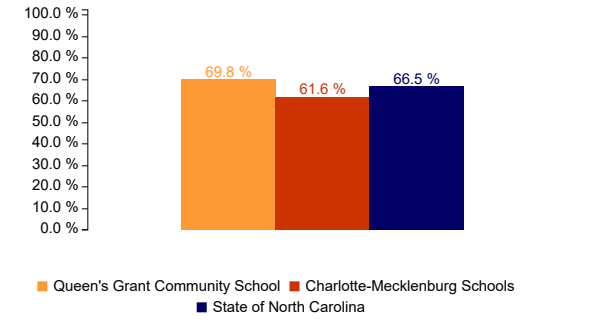

Percent Scoring 17 or above at Queen's Grant Commu

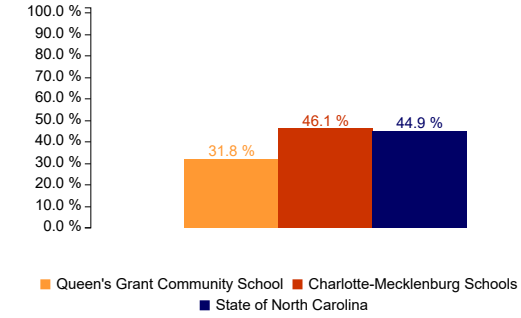


ACT/ACT WorkKeys Combined Indicator

The percentage of 12th grade students who were awarded at least a Silver Level Career Readiness Certificate or scoring 17 or above at Queen's Grant Commu

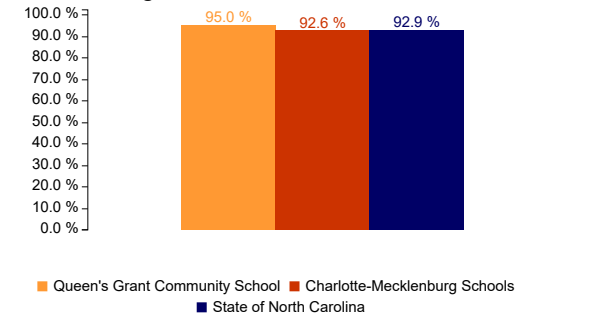


English Learner Progress

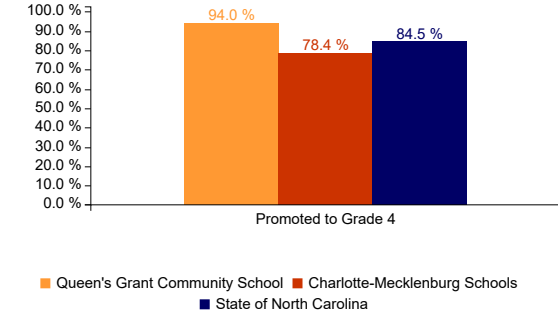


Passing Math 3

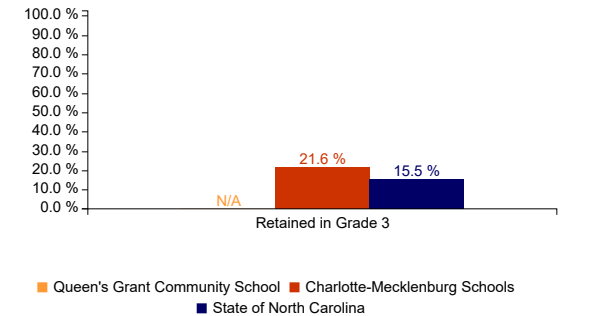
Percent Passing at Queen's Grant Commu

Read to Achieve - Retained in Grade 3



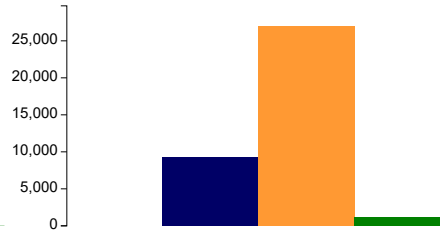

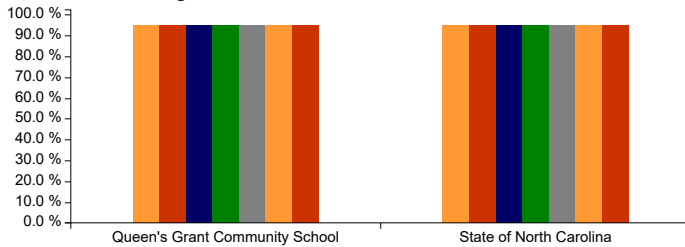

Students with Disabilities Alternate Test Participation

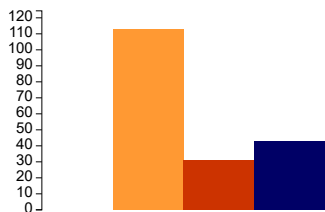

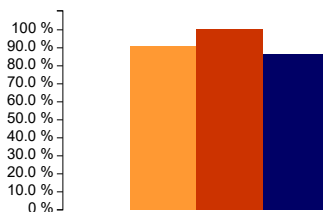

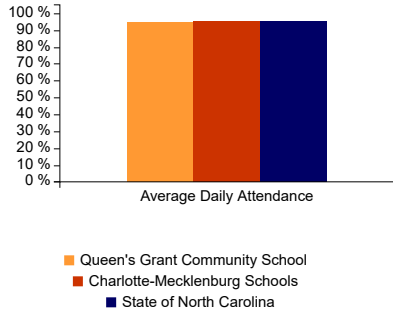

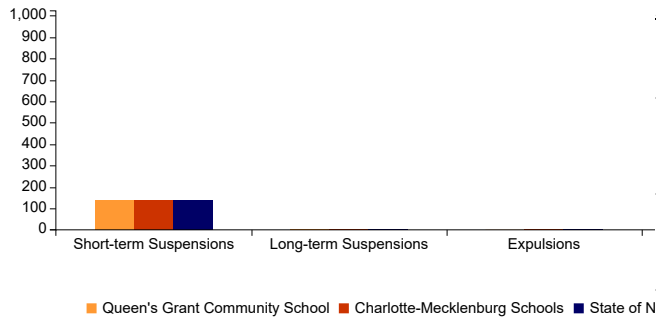

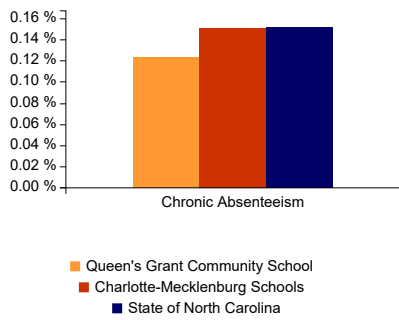

Students Per Device

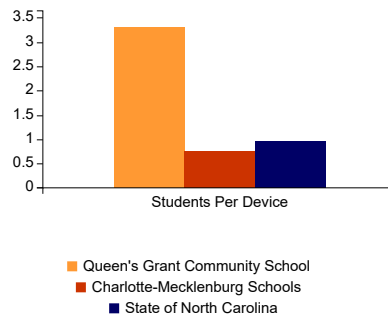

Book Titles Per Student

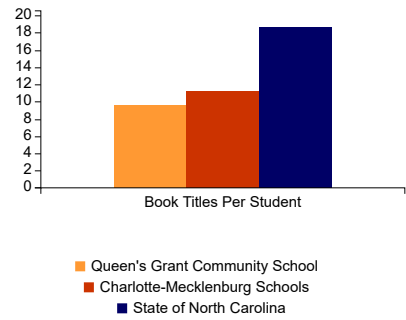

Wireless Access Points per Classroom

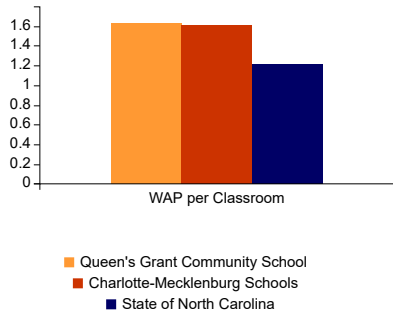

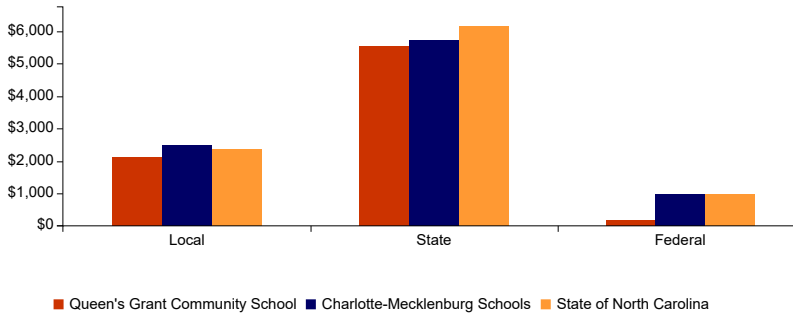

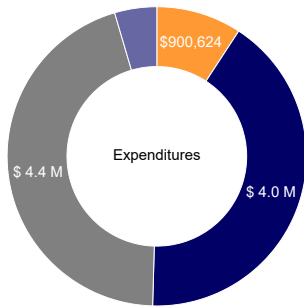

Per Pupil Source of Funding

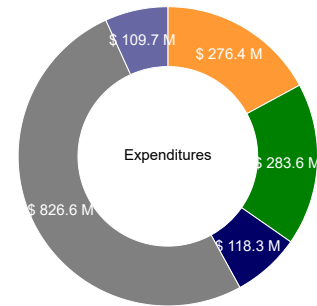

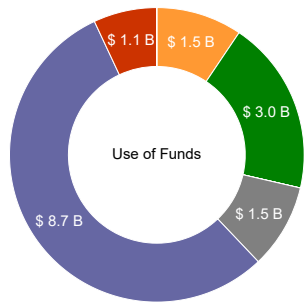
