Summary: FARROP Guide - Using the Formative Assessment Rubrics, Reflection and Observation tools to Support Professional Reflection on Practice - The purpose of the document is to provide guidelines and resources for the use in observations and reflections on formative assessment practices. Teachers would choose a dimension they would like to improve, intentionally plan lessons for the implementation of that dimension, implement the lesson, reflection on implementation using the rubric, and identify next steps. This guide was commissioned by the Formative Assessment for Students and Teachers State Collaborative on Assessment and Student Standards (FAST SCASS) of the Council of Chief State and School Officers and piloted nationally in 18 states. The document includes: background information on formative assessment; discussion of the value of informal self-reflection or peer observations as a way to improve formative assessment practice; a set of rubrics for ten dimensions of formative assessment and guidelines for how to use both the self-reflection and peer observation tools.
