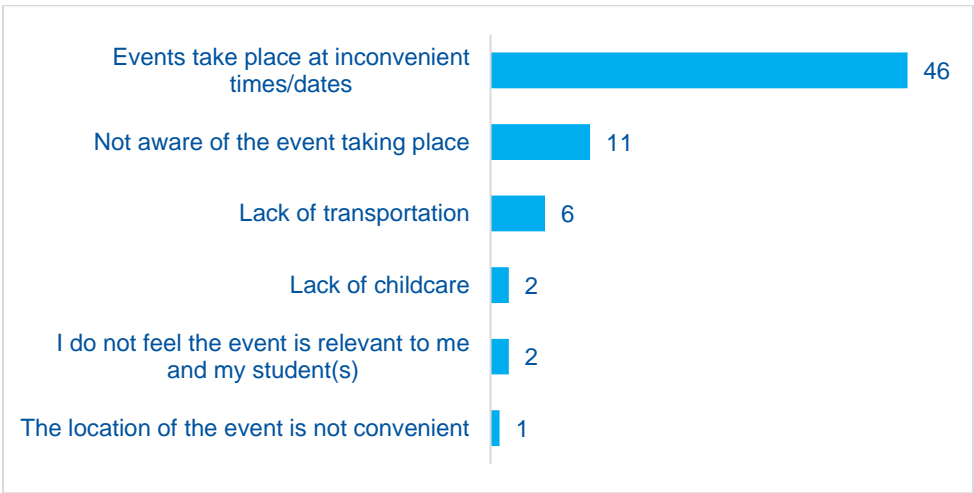

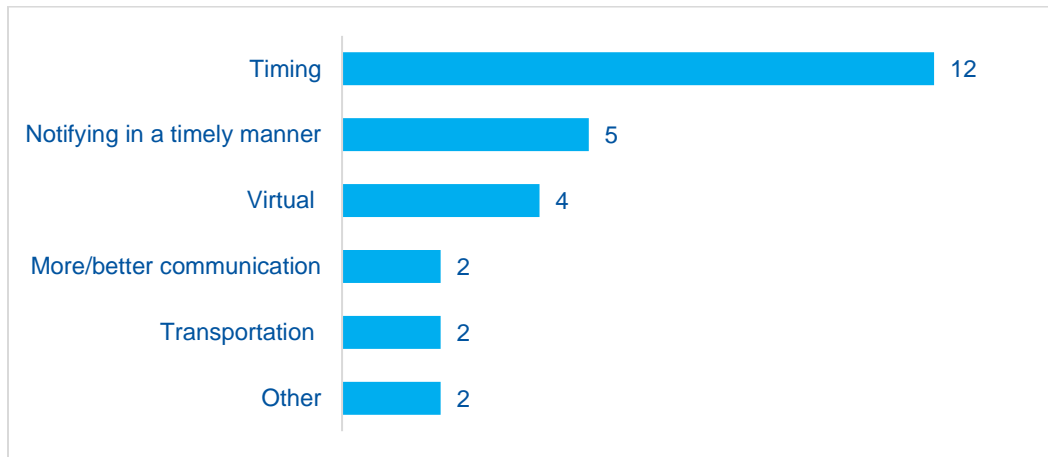

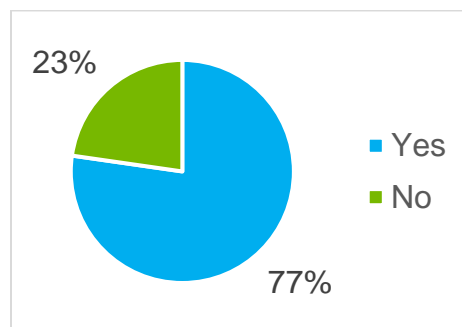
What is the most likely reason you would not attend a parent and family engagement event?

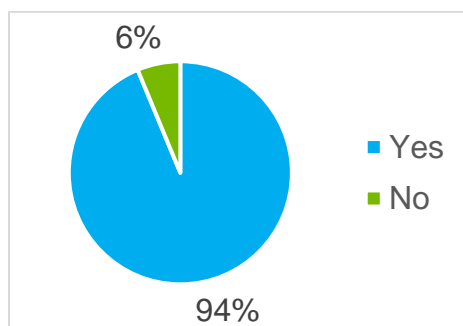

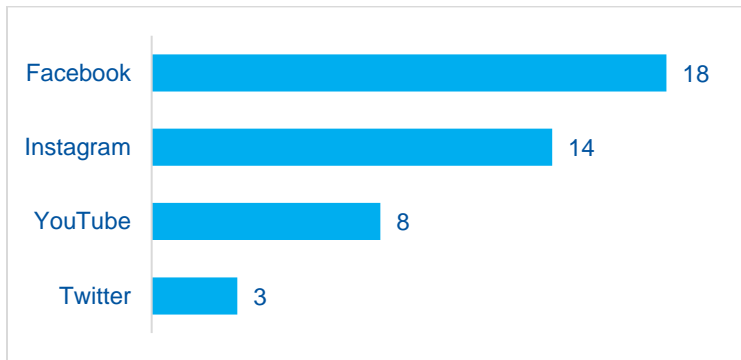

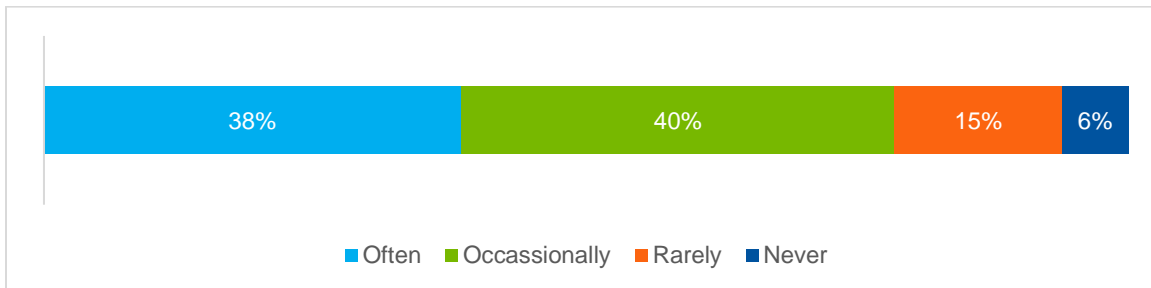

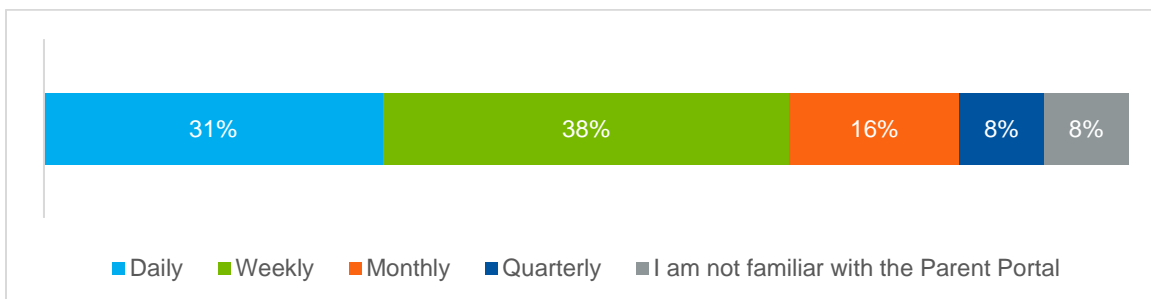
Do you follow the school on social media? Please check all that apply.



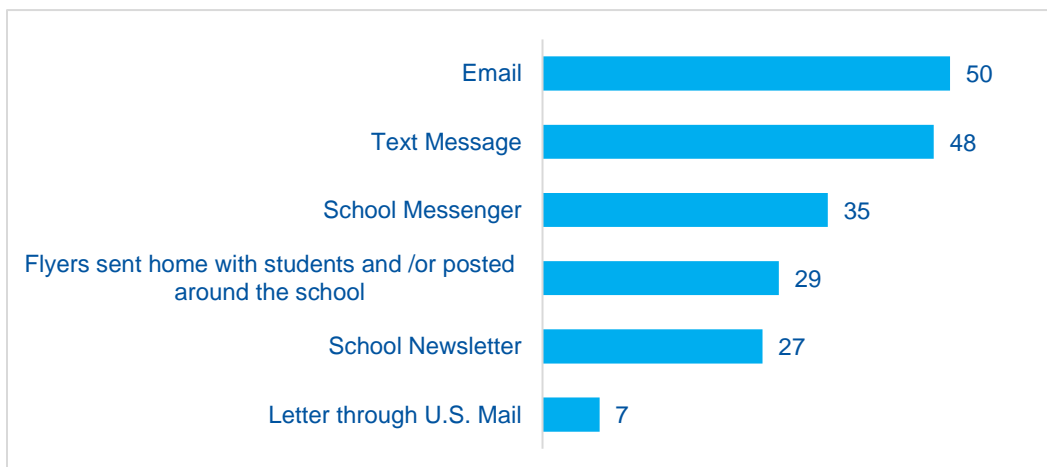
How often do you visit our school website for reasons other than the Parent Portal?



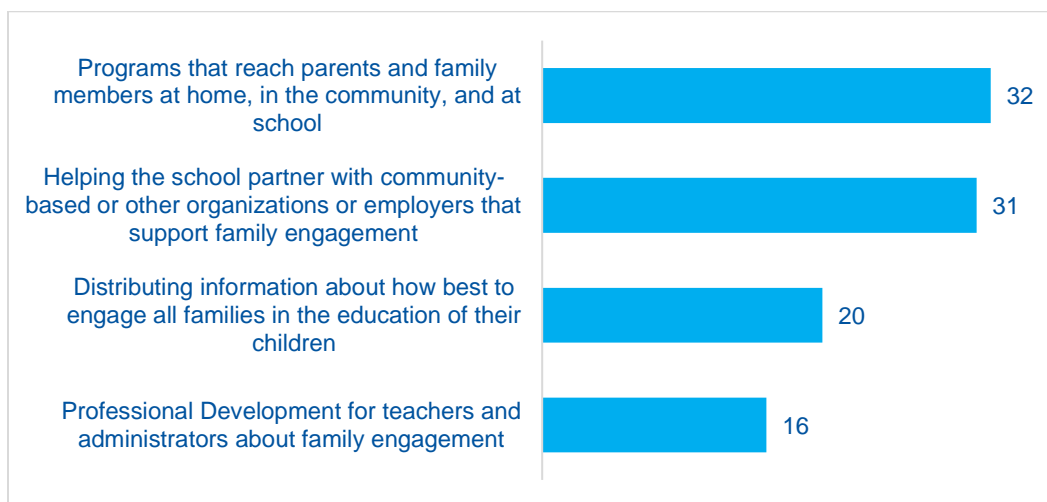
How often do you log into the Parent Portal?
