Summary: Corrective Reading is designed to promote reading accuracy (decoding), fluency, and comprehension skills of students in grade 3 or higher who are reading below their grade level. The program has four levels that correspond to students' decoding skills. All lessons in the program are sequenced and scripted. Corrective Reading can be implemented in small groups of 4-5 students or in a whole-class format. Corrective Reading is intended to be taught in 45-minute lessons 4-5 times a week.

Summary: Check & Connect is an intervention to reduce dropping out of school. It is based on monitoring of school performance, mentoring, case management, and other supports. The "Check" component is designed to continually monitor student performance and progress. The "Connect" component involves program staff giving individualized attention to students in partnership with other school staff, family members, and community service organizations. Students enrolled in Check & Connect are assigned a "monitor" who regularly reviews information on attendance, behavior, or academic problems and intervenes when problems are identified. The monitor also advocates for students, coordinates services, provides ongoing feedback and encouragement, and emphasizes the importance of staying in school.

Summary: Research shows that family engagement is most effective when focused on specific student outcomes. Authentic family engagement involves families partnering with schools and community organizations to support and monitor their children's educational and behavioral goals. High-quality family engagement is strongly linked to improved learning outcomes, including higher academic achievement, better attendance, more positive attitudes toward school, and increased graduation rates. A meta-analysis of 28 studies found a strong, significant relationship between family engagement and student achievement from early childhood through high school. Activities that set high expectations and help students connect learning to real-world experiences are the strongest predictors of success.
