In accordance with section 1112(e)(2)(a) of the *Every Student Succeeds Act* (ESSA), we are writing to provide information regarding the state-required assessments that will be administered this year among students at Emerson Academy of Dayton.

The goal of the Ohio State Board of Education's strategic plan, "*Each Child, Our Future*" is to... "ensure every child is challenged, prepared and empowered to become a resilient, lifelong learner who contributes to society."

To measure student progress toward this goal, and maintain a focus on educational equity and excellence, the law maintains that all students are required to take annual statewide assessments. To provide assessment transparency, we would like to share with you below, the various state assessments that we are required to administer to our students throughout the school year.

- Alternate Assessment for Students with Significant Cognitive Disabilities (AASCD)
