

Young 5's Supply List

Things to bring each day

- ◊ Backpack - large enough for lunch box, snacks, chromebook, and folders
- ◊ Morning and afternoon healthy snacks - labeled snack 1 and snack 2, placed in a bag separate from lunch box, please know your child and keep in mind if he/she may need 2 items to snack on at each snack time
- ◊ Lunch (if not purchasing school lunch) - lunch box labeled with student's name
For the first week of school, please send peanut-free items until we can confirm allergies.
- ◊ Water Bottle - labeled with student's name and sent daily

Classroom supplies to bring during the first week

- ◊ Change of clothes—to be left in backpack in case of spills or accidents, in a Zip-loc bag with your student's name on it (underwear, socks, shirt, pants - all labeled) These MUST be dress code
- ◊ 2 two pocket plastic folders labeled with student name
- ◊ 1 12 pack of pre-sharpened Ticonderoga pencils
- ◊ 1 pencil box labeled with child's name - the plastic ones are best please
- ◊ 3 boxes of 8 count crayons
- ◊ 2 packages of 4 or more Expo brand dry erase markers
- ◊ 2 packages of 4 or more fine tip dry erase markers
- ◊ 1 individual dry erase eraser
- ◊ 12 pack or more of gluesticks
- ◊ 1 package of Pipsqueaks Markers of 8 count
- ◊ 1 package of 12 count colored pencils
- ◊ 2 hi-lighters
- ◊ 1 Primary lined writing notebooks - Please be sure they are primary lined and not college rule, wide rule, etc.. you can get these on Amazon, at Target, Office Max, etc..
- ◊ 1 drawing notebook (blank white paper)
- ◊ 1 Bag of Kinetic Sand
- ◊ 2 boxes of Kleenex
- ◊ 3 containers of Clorox wipes
- ◊ 2 pairs of scissors
- ◊ 3 rolls of paper towel
- ◊ 1 box/bag or more of extra snacks for the classroom (peanut free)
- ◊ 2 containers of play dough
- ◊ Stickers for the class
- ◊ 3 ink pads any colors
- ◊ 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- ◊ 1 box of gallon size baggies and 1 box of sandwich or Quart size baggies
- ◊ 1 dry erase clipboard

Other Items
