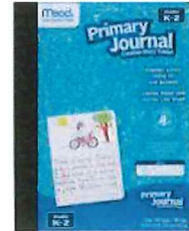

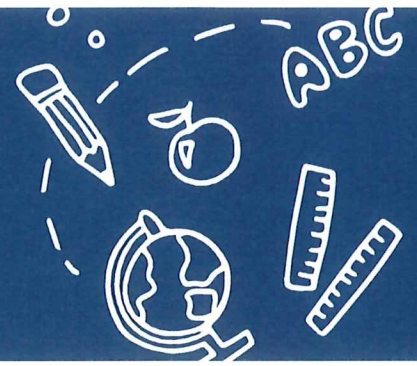

 - One 3 inch binder for Social Studies
- 4 composition notebooks - One for each class (in addition to the spiral notebooks)
- 1 additional notebook of any type to be used for Encore classes
- Glue stick - (at least two) for adding print-outs to Lab Notebook
- 2 (1.5 inch) binders for Science and Social Studies – Used for organizing papers
 - Loose leaf paper - to go in the binder.
 - Tab dividers (10) – 6 to organize Social Studies binder and 4 for Science
- Calculator*
 - TI-34 is a great calculator, but any calculator will work for Pre-Algebra
 - Graphing Calculator- Possible is TI-84 for Algebra 1 only

- Pencils - enough for the whole year
- Pens - black or blue preferred
- Colored pencils – 1 multi-color package
- Highlighters
- Scissors
- Protractor – (these are sold at the dollar store) – Suggested for Math class
- Planner (suggested) – to keep track of assignments and school events

- Dry erase markers (suggested)
- Ruler (suggested)

*** While we have some calculators for classroom use, we encourage students to purchase their own calculator to use for homework. We recommend purchasing a Ti-83 or Ti-84 for a graphing calculator (which will be required for Algebra and Geometry courses in High School and College) or T130XIIS for a scientific calculator.
