Personal Supplies, labeled w/ student's name

****Special note about shoes:** Typically, Y5 students are not able to tie their own shoes yet & it is a significant challenge to tie the shoes of an entire class. We are requesting that children have Velcro shoes for gym. Plan to have your child wear these to school on gym days and we can save 20 minutes changing shoes before gym class. Boots, sandals, flipflops, & ballet flats are not allowed in the gym. Thank-you so much for your understanding!

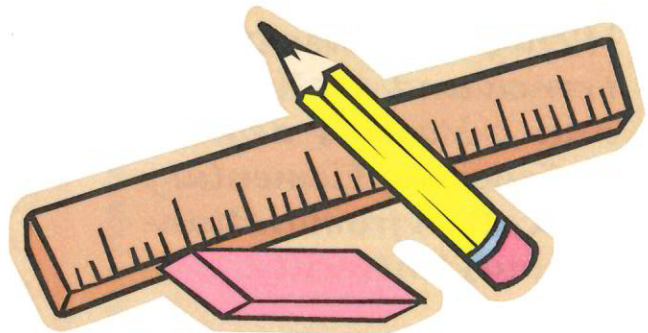
1ST GRADE

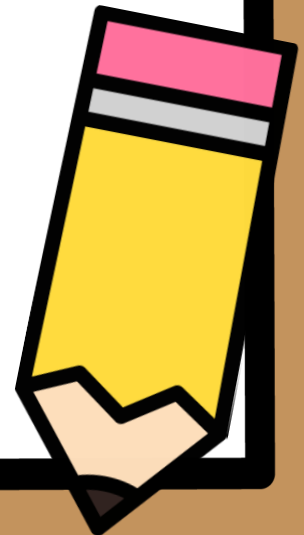

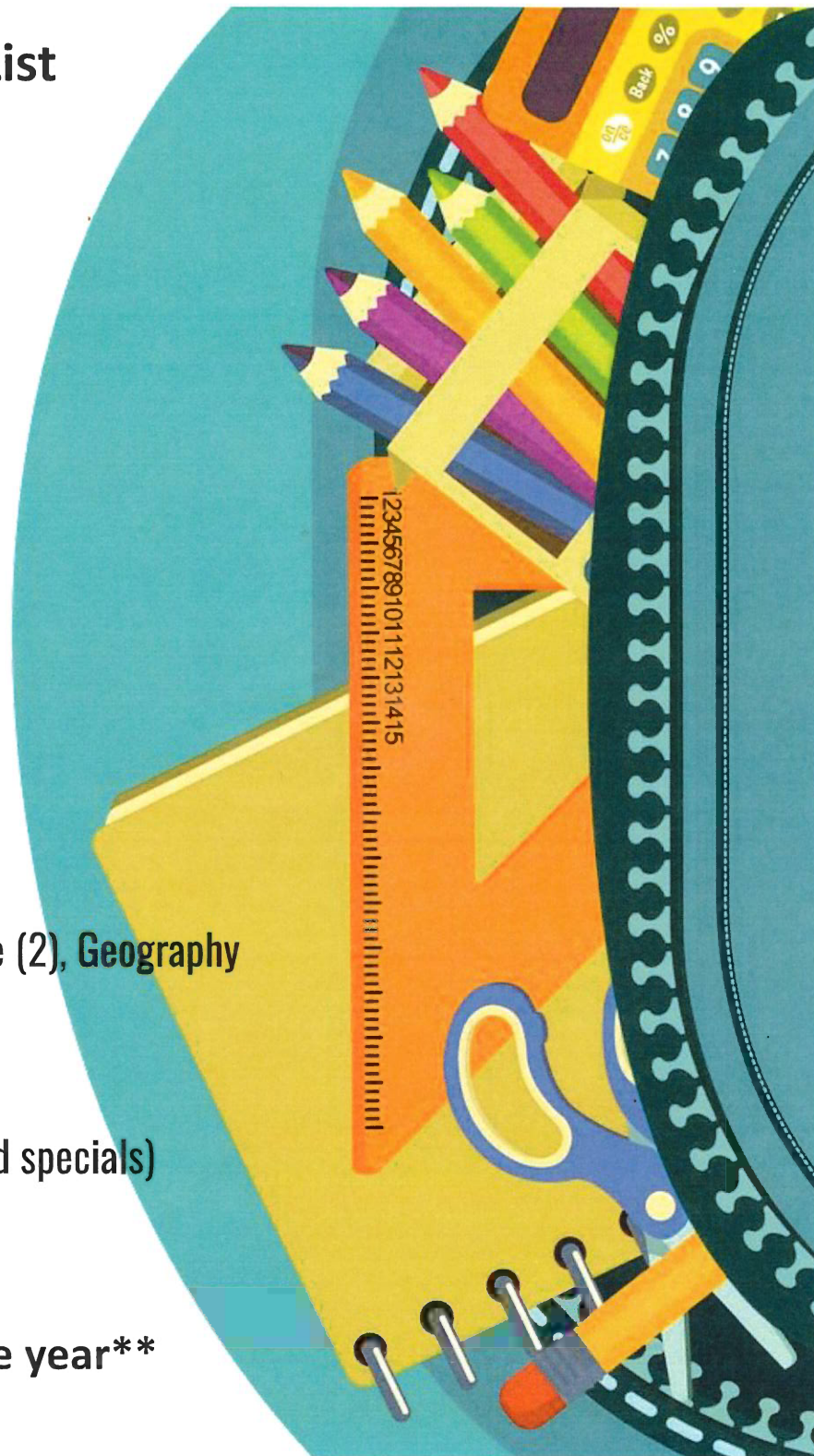
