- Ziploc bags (all sizes)

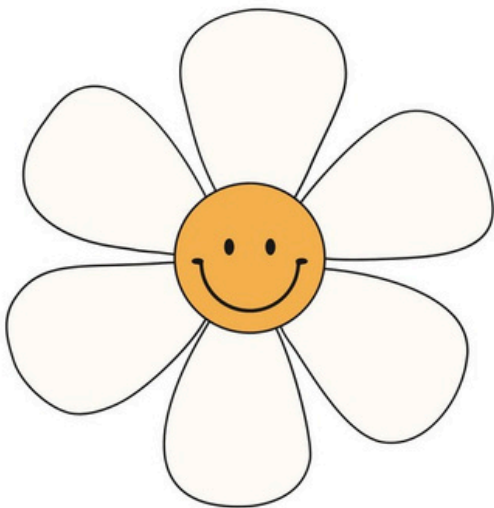
