

# Young 5's Supply List 26-27

Things to bring each day:

- Backpack** – Please provide a large enough for lunchbox, snacks, chrome book, and folders.
- Morning and afternoon healthy snacks** – Please label “snack 1” and “snack 2,” and place in a bag separate from lunch. Pack enough for your child’s appetite!
- Lunch** (if not purchasing school hot lunch) – Please label lunch box with student’s name. \*For the first week of school, please send peanut-free items until we can confirm allergies!
- Water bottle** – Please label with student’s name and send daily.

Classroom supplies to **bring the first week of school:**

- 1 or 2 changes of clothes – This is in case of spills or accidents. Please pack in a large Ziplock bag labeled with your student’s name. Include underwear, socks, shirt, and pants – all labeled individually! All items MUST be dress code appropriate.
- 2 two-pocket plastic folders labeled with student’s name
- 1 dozen pre-sharpened Ticonderoga pencils
- 1 plastic pencil box labeled with student’s name
- 3 boxes of eight-count crayons
- 2 packages of four (or more) Expo brand dry-erase markers, 2 packages of four (or more) fine tip dry-erase markers, 1 individual dry-erase eraser, 1 dry-erase clipboard
- 1 dozen (or more) glue sticks
- 1 package (eight count) of Pipsqueaks Markers
- 1 package of twelve-count colored pencils
- 2 highlighters
- 1 primary-lined writing notebook – Please be sure to buy “primary-lined” and not college rule, wide rule, etc. Available at Amazon, Target, Office Max, etc.
- 1 drawing notebook (blank white paper)
- 1 bag kinetic sand
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 3 containers of Clorox wipes
- 2 pairs of scissors
- 3 rolls of paper towel
- 1 box/bag of extra snacks for the classroom (peanut free)
- 2 containers of play dough
- Stickers for the classroom
- 3 ink pads, any color
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 box of gallon size baggies
- 1 box of sandwich or quart-size baggies

Optional items: (1) Noise canceling sensory headphones and (2) Winter gear bag

**Note:** (1) For winter, it works best for students to have a pair of boots, snow pants, hat, and a pair of waterproof gloves that stay here at school. Please make sure they are all labeled with your student’s name. (2) **Send items in a little at a time, during the first week. Parents will NOT be permitted to walk to classrooms.**

# Kindergarten Supply List 26-27

Personal Supplies – Label EACH item with your student’s name.

- 1 regular-sized backpack (big enough to hold a folder, water bottle, Chromebook, and lunchbox)
