

Kindergarten Supply List

*All supplies must be labeled with child's name.
Supplies are for individual use: no sharing among students.*

In child's backpack include:

- Uniform-appropriate change of clothes, including socks and underpants (in a Ziploc bag)
- Velcro athletic shoes for gym class (these are to stay at school)
- 3 sturdy, plain, plastic pocket folders (no prong) labeled with your child's name- 1 green, 1 orange, 1 red
- 1 white 1-inch binder with clear plastic view, labeled with your child's name on the inside
- Small box of Kleenex (to be kept on child's desk)
- 2 (9oz or larger) bottles of hand sanitizer, labeled with child's name
- 1 container of Clorox wipes
- 1 box Ziploc gallon bags (girls only)
- 1 box Ziploc sandwich bags (boys only)
- 2 primary journals (blank space on top, lines on bottom)



In a pencil box/bag include:

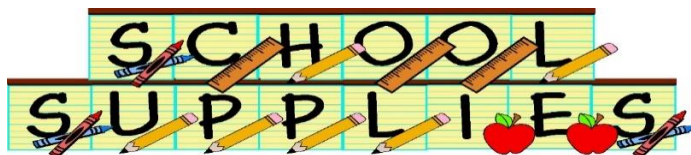

 - one notebook exclusively for each class

 - Glue stick - (at least one) for adding print-outs to Lab Notebook
- 1 (1.5 inch) binder for Social Studies – Used for organizing papers
 - Loose leaf paper - to go in the binder.
 - Tab dividers (six) – to organize Social Studies binder
- Calculator*
 - TI-34 is a great calculator, but any calculator will work for Pre-Algebra
 - Graphing Calculator- Possible is TI-84 for Algebra 1 only
- Protractor – (these are sold at the dollar store)
- Graph paper - 1 package - for Math class
- Pencils - enough for the whole year
- Pens (black or blue preferred)
- Colored pencil – 1 multi-color package
- Highlighters
- Markers (suggested)
- Dry erase markers

- Ruler
