Hello Scholars and Parents,

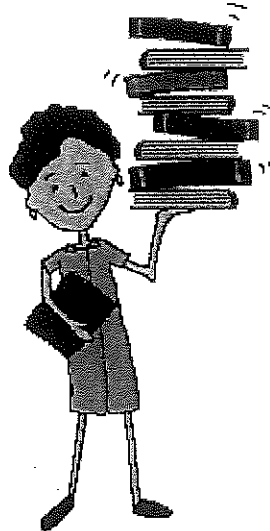
