***** Please do NOT purchase giant binders or accordian folders! We advise that your child has a separate folder and notebook for EACH subject instead. They can swap out materials when transitioning between classes rather than taking everything with them.*****

Required:

- (5 to 7) folders with pockets to use in each class
- (3) spiral bound notebooks (college ruled – one for Science, one for Math, and one for World History) ****For grading purposes, please have separate notebook for each class rather than one large notebook divided into sections****
- (1) 100 page composition notebook for ELA
- (1) 3-ring, 1 inch binder
- 1 - Package of 5 tabbed dividers (for binder)
- (1) handheld pencil sharpener
- (3) Packets of 200-400 sheets of lined paper; 3-hole punched, college ruled (to be used for class notes and daily assignments)
- Mechanical pencils
- Black/Blue Pens (no brightly colored)
- Pads of Post-It notes (1 pack of 12)
- 200 index cards (size 3x5 lined)
- Highlighters
- Protractor (used during 2nd and 3rd trimester in math)
- Compass (used during 2nd and 3rd trimester in math)
- **STUDENTS TAKING SPANISH:** one folder for each trimester you are enrolled in Spanish

For Classroom Use (bring to “Meet the Teacher” night or first day of school):
