## Every Student Needs:

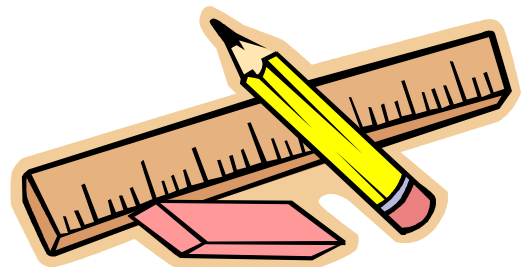


# 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Supply List

Your second grader will need:

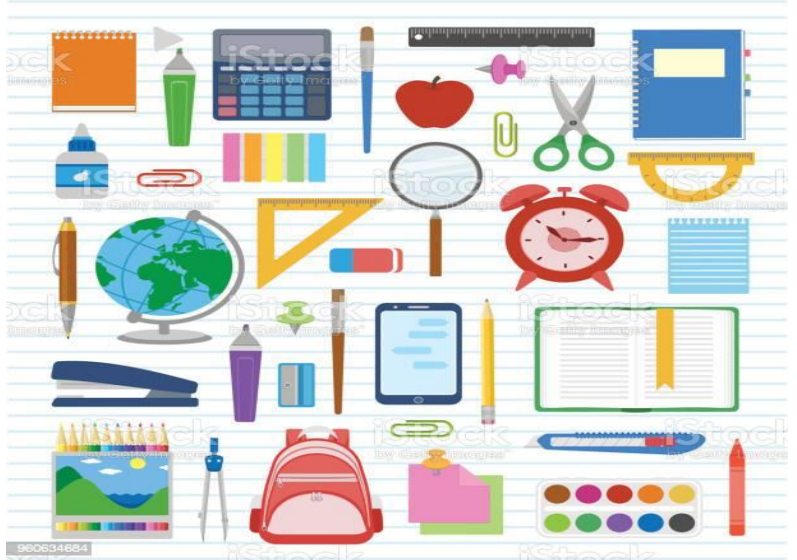
- 1 plastic pencil box (large enough to hold pencil, crayon box, scissors, etc.)

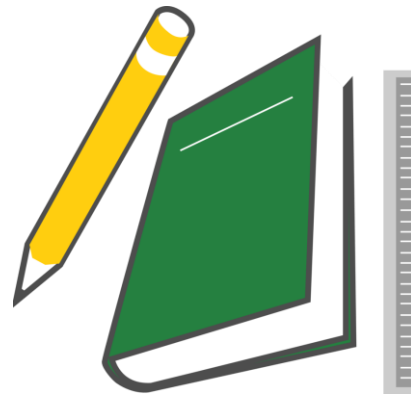

  - ✓ No markers please
- 2 packages of lined paper (college ruled)
- 1 package of red pens
- 2 yellow highlighters
- Blue and Black ball point pens
- 1 folder with prongs of each of the following colors: red, green, purple, blue, and yellow, and orange (with students' names on the front right corner)
- 1 spiral bound notebook of each of the following colors: red, green, purple, blue, and yellow, and orange (with students' names on the front right corner)
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener with lid
- Personal water bottle
