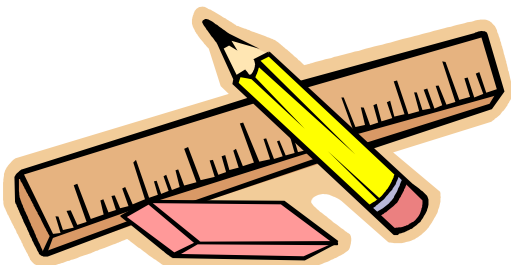

Every Student Needs:

- 1 pencil **bag** (small)
 - ✓ No hard boxes or containers please
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 small box of crayons (no more than 24 please) or 1 box of colored pencils
 - ✓ No markers please
- 2 packages of lined paper (college ruled)
- 1 package of red pens
- 2 yellow highlighters
- Blue and Black ball point pens
- 1 folder with prongs of each of the following colors: red, green, purple, blue, and yellow, and orange (with students' names on the front right corner)
- 1 spiral bound notebook of each of the following colors: red, green, purple, blue, and yellow, and orange (with students' names on the front right corner)
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener with lid
- Personal water bottle
- 1 dry erase board (can be found at dollar store)

Classroom Community Supplies:

- Non-perishable snacks - Goldfish, graham crackers, fruit/granola bars, applesauce-one donation per family (more than one will be kindly appreciated)
