- Ballpoint pens

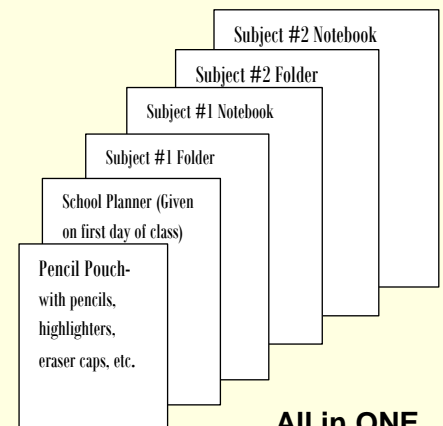
Seventh/Eighth Grade Supply List-Continued
