## Second Grade

- ◇ Crayons (24 count)
- ◇ Pencils ( 4 dozen)
- ◇ Small pencil box or pouch
- ◇ Scissors (children's pointed)
- ◇ 4 Dry Erase markers (no board cleaner please)
- ◇ White board eraser or sock
- ◇ Erasers (cap- optional)

- ◇ Plain, cheap, two pocket folders without fasteners, 1 each in the following colors: red, yellow, green, blue, orange
- ◇ 3 boxes of tissue
- ◇ 1 yellow highlighter
- ◇ 2 rolls of paper towel
- ◇ 2 containers of baby wipes
- ◇ Quart sized zip lock baggies (last name A-L) or gallon size zip lock baggies (last name M-Z)
- ◇ 1 box of band aids (optional)



## Third Grade

- ◇ 4 Pink Rectangle Erasers

- ◇ 2 boxes of Kleenex tissues

- ◇ 5 folders with pockets (different colors)

- ◇ Extra pencils and erasers

## Fourth Grade


- ◇ 1 zippered pencil bag (no boxes please)

- ◇ 8 or 12 count of dry erase markers \*high need item\*
- ◇ 2 rolls of paper towel
- ◇ 1 pack of highlighters

- ◇ 1 box of Band-aids
- ◇ 3 containers of disinfecting wipes (not baby wipes please)
- ◇ 1 pad of post-it notes

- ◇ 1 Package of colored pencils OR 24 count crayons
- ◇ 3 Glue Sticks
- ◇ 1 1/2" Binder for Social Studies-NO TRAPPER KEEPERS!!!
- ◇ Zippered pencil BAG (please NO PENCIL BOXES)
- ◇ 4 plastic/poly pocket folders (1 folder with prongs)
- ◇ Ear buds for Chromebooks
