- 1 complete set of **extra school clothes** including underwear and socks inside a gallon-sized bag with your child's name (for accidents and spills)





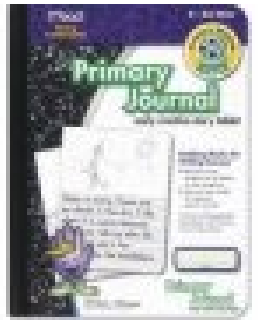

1st Grade Supply List

Required Items

- One backpack with name
 - no wheels please
- Five two-pocket folders
 - Yellow, Blue, Red, Orange and Green
 - plastic folders preferred (especially yellow)
 - labeled with child's name
- One pencil box (no zippered pouches please):
 - Labeled with student's name
 - Approximately 5" x 8"
- Two 24 count boxes of crayons
- One pack of 2 glue sticks
- Two boxes of tissues
- Two packages of 4 thick black dry erase Expo markers
 - low-odor please
- 1 Pair kid (safety) scissors
- Two Primary Level Composition Notebooks (available at Walmart and Office Depot)
 - lines should look like this → 
- Two boxes of *pre-sharpened* pencils
 - Ticonderoga preferred
- One pink eraser (no eraser caps)

A Note about Lockers:

All items stored in lockers must be school-related. Students must use school-issued padlock to keep personal belongings safe throughout the day. Students may adorn the inside of their lockers with inspirational pictures or encouraging words from parents, teachers, or friends.
