Dear GRA Families:

We are delighted to share that our spring NWEA test results show our students made OUTSTANDING growth this year. As we finish another successful year, our thoughts turn to preventing summer loss. Summer loss (often called "summer slide") refers to the loss in academic skills and knowledge over summer vacation. All young people experience learning losses when they do not engage in educational activities during the summer. Research shows that students typically score lower on standardized tests at the end of summer vacation than they do on the same tests at the beginning of the summer. The good news is that you can help your child stay academically active during the summer because Grand River Academy is providing an at-home summer program to ALL Y5/K-7th grade students FREE OF CHARGE!

<u>Scholastic Summer Reading Program (Grades Y5/K-7):</u> A few months ago, all students in grades Y5/K-7th selected books at their reading level. On the last day of school these books will be sent home for students to read throughout the summer months. As your student(s) complete their book, they are encouraged to go online to our Survey Monkey and complete a short summary of the book. You can enter the survey information at the following website:

<u>Summer Bridge Activities Workbook (Grades Y5/K-7):</u> Each student has a Summer Bridge Activities Workbook to complete during the summer. Summer Bridge Workbooks include 60 days of activities in the book, divided into three sections. This provides one page (two-sided) of work for every weekday of the summer. <u>It is highly recommended that you spread this book out throughout the summer and DO NOT complete it in one sitting.</u> The activities in the workbook include reading, writing, math, science, social studies and fitness.
