


Community supplies for the classroom (put in a bag or box labeled with your child's name):

- (2) rolls of paper towels
- (1) package of napkins
- (2) boxes of tissues
- (3) containers of Clorox wipes
- (1) box/bag of **healthy** snacks *value size appreciated* (pretzels, crackers, etc.)
- (1) <u>24-pack</u> of yellow #2 pencils
- (4) pink block erasers (non-marking)
- (10) glue sticks
- (3) Dry-Erase Markers (black only)
- (1) 8 oz. bottle of hand sanitizer (with pump)
- (1) box of plastic baggies according to your child's last name: Last names that start with A-F: snack; G-L: gallon; M-R: quart; S-Z: sandwich

Individual supplies for the student (label <u>ALL</u> items with your child's name using a permanent marker):



- (5) **24-count** boxes of crayons
- (1) pair of kids' scissors (Fiskars brand recommended)
- (1) backpack (should be able to fit a standard size folder)


- o 50 yellow #2 pencils / please no designs. They ruin our sharpeners:

Dear Parents,

As a Middle School Team, we have worked hard to look at our supply list and determine which specific supplies will work best for each classroom. We have attempted to make our supply list as simple as possible and keep the cost down to a minimum.

Pathway Middle School students do not have the typical "school fees" other middle schools require students to pay, so we do ask that every student starts the year with this list of supplies.

## Supplies for the classroom

These supplies will be turned into the teacher on the first day of school and will be used throughout the year in the classroom. A few of the items will go to the Specials teachers in order to help supply their classrooms as well.

- (3) boxes of tissues (one will be for Specials)
- (3) rolls of paper towels
- (3) containers of Clorox wipes
- (1) package of graph paper with the three holes for their binder (Math)
- (2) glue sticks for Art
- (1) 2-pack of wide tip black dry erase markers NO color markers (Math)
- (1) pkg. lined index cards
- (1) pkg. multi-colored highlighters (Reading)

## Supplies for the student

These supplies are required for each individual student's personal use. Students are required to have these supplies with them every day throughout the entire school year. **Teachers will not collect these items as it is the student's responsibility to ensure they have them every day.** <u>Items marked with an (\*) are items we recommend you purchase multiple packages of in August while</u> the school supplies are on sale.

### **ALL Middle School Students**

- (6) brown paper grocery bags for covering text books (NO store bought book covers may be used. We have newer textbooks in most classes and the brown grocery bags protect them best.)
- multiple packages of pencils \*
- multiple packages of loose leaf wide-ruled notebook paper \*

- cheap pair of earbuds (NO large headphones) in a <u>Ziploc bag to be left at school for projects using technology</u>

#### 6th Grade

- (3) composition books 100 pages (2 for Reading and 1 for Sci/Soc.St)
- (3) 3 ring binder (1½" with plastic outer sleeve and inside pockets)

## 7th Grade

- (1) composition book 100 pages (for Reading)
- (4) 3 ring binder (1" with plastic outer sleeve and inside pockets)
- (1) calculator for HOME use (TI-30XIIS) is suggested for all 7<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- spiral notebook (Social Studies)
- plastic folder (Social Studies)

### 8th Grade

- (1) composition book 100 pages (for Reading)
- (4) 3 ring binder (1" with plastic outer sleeve and inside pockets)
- (1) calculator for HOME use (TI-30XIIS) is suggested for all 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- spiral notebook (Social Studies)
- plastic folder (Social Studies)
