Kindergarten

Individual supplies:

- Backpack
- 1 one-inch 3-ring binder with clear front pocket and 2 inside pockets
- 3 Crayola 24 pack of crayons
- 10 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 bottle of liquid glue
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 set of over-the-ear headphones
- 1 crayon bin/ crayon bag

Recommended donations:

- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- Gallon sized Ziploc bags
- Sandwich sized Ziploc bags
- Play-Doh
- 2 packs of baby wipes
- 1 tub of Clorox wipes

1st Grade

Individual supplies:

- 2 boxes of pencils
- 1 pencil case
- 2 pkgs of crayons (24 pack)
- 5 Glue sticks
- 1 pkg. dry erase markers

Recommended donations:

- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towel
- 1 box of sandwich bags
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes

2nd Grade

Individual supplies:

- 2 two-pocket **plastic** folders – **one green** and **one red**
- 1 box of 8 thick washable markers
- 1 box of 24 count crayons
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 school supply box/pouch with zipper
(must be able to fit in child's desk)
- 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks
- 1 backpack (no wheels)
- 1 sock/eraser (to erase individual whiteboards)
- 4 **THICK** dry erase markers

Recommended donations:

- 36 pencils
- Two packs of glue sticks
- 1 package of Clorox wipes
- 4 boxes of tissue
- 1 roll of paper towel (boys only)
- 1 box of band-aids (girls only)
- Hand sanitizer with a pump

3rd Grade

Individual supplies:

- 1 pencil pouch (about 8x5)
- 1 package pencils
- 4 pocket folders (plastic and 4 different colors)
- 2 70-page wide ruled spiral notebook
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 box of crayons or colored pencils (max 24)
- 3 boxes Kleenex
- 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 pair of scissors
- 4 pack whiteboard markers

Recommended donations:

- 1 pack pencil top erasers
- 1 roll paper towel
- Ziploc bags (sandwich & gallon size)

4th Grade

- 5 pocket folders: Red (math), blue (language arts), green (science), yellow (social studies), choose your own design (homework)
- 4 one-subject spiral notebooks: Red (math), blue (language arts), green (science), yellow (social studies)
- 2 pkgs. of erasers– 1 pencil top and 1 pink pearl
- 1 pkg. of crayons (16-24 count) and 1 pkg. of colored pencils
- 1 pkg. of washable markers (8 count)
- 1 pkg. of dry erase markers and 1 dry eraser
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair of student scissors
- 2 highlighters
- 2 packs pencils (24 count)
- 1 pack of loose leaf lined paper
- 4 boxes of facial tissue
- 2-4 containers of Clorox wipes

5th Grade

Individual supplies:

- 1 package of dry erase markers
- 4 college composition notebooks
- 1 pencil bag/case
- 5 pocket folders (any colors)
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 box markers or colored pencils

Recommended donations:

- 4 boxes of Kleenex
- 3 boxes of #2 pencils
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 1 package of index cards

6th Grade

Individual supplies:

- Pocket folders:
3 blue (math) 3 yellow (language arts)
2 green (science) 2 red (social studies)
2 purple (moral focus and morning work)
2 choose your own design (homework)
- One-subject notebooks:
2 blue (math) 2 yellow (language arts)
2 green (science) 2 red (social studies)
2 black (moral focus and morning work)
- 3 packages of index cards
- 2 packs of lined paper
- 4 glue sticks
- 3 large packs of pencils
- 1 highlighter, 1 pencil pouch, 1 pair of scissors

Recommended donations:

- 1 box of gallon Ziploc bags (boys)
- 1 box of sandwich Ziploc bags (girls)
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer (boys)
- 2 containers of Clorox wipes (girls)
- 4 boxes of Kleenex

7th/8th Grade

Individual supplies:

- 1 large accordion folder
- 2 plastic folders with brads and pockets
- 2 composition notebooks (Moral Focus/Elective)
- 2 packages of index cards
- 1 red checking pen
- 2 boxes of tissue
- 2 boxes of pencils
- 2 packs of lined paper
- 4 single subject spiral notebooks for core classes OR
1 five subject notebook

Recommended donations:

- 1 container of disinfecting wet wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- White board markers
- 1 glue stick
