Binder Assembly Directions

1. Open the binder prongs and insert the 2 plastic folders on the right side.
2. Label the folders with the following: folder 1: Homework, folder 2: Unfinished work.
3. On top of the folder insert the pencil pouch.
4. Close the prongs.
5. Once your student comes to school we will add their agenda, and page protectors for the school calendar, and spelling words.

Labeling Other Supplies

1. Please label the composition notebooks with the student's name.
2. If your student is going to bring their own headphones to school please label them with their name. If they are the small earbuds please wrap a piece of tape on them with the student's name. Please put the headphones/earbuds in a ziploc bag. It is up to the student to be responsible for their headphones. They need to keep them in their backpack if they choose to use their own.
