Over the next 2 years, our uniform policy at Quest Charter Academy will change. We will be slowly implementing a new dress code and are excited to see our students embrace it.

We understand that changing the uniform policy completely over one summer could be a bit overwhelming, that's why we have developed a two-year transition plan. When purchasing clothing for the 2019-2020 school year, please keep in mind the new requirement for the 2020-2021 school year. Following is information regarding our uniform requirements and ordering options.

2019-2020 Uniform Requirements

Grades K-5

Solid bright green, white, light gray, or light blue collared shirts

Navy pants

Grades 6-8

Solid bright green, white, navy, light gray, or light blue collared shirts

Optional white dress shirt with bright green/navy striped tie

Navy or khaki pants

2020-2021 Uniform Requirements

Grades K-5

Solid bright green or white collared shirts

Navy pants

Grades 6-8

Solid bright green or white collared shirts

Optional white dress shirt with bright green/navy striped tie

Navy or khaki pants

Uniform Vendor

NHA has partnered with a uniform vendor, Image Builders Marketing. Bright green polo shirts and custom green and blue ties must be purchased through Image Builders. Parental Partnership: Dress Code

To enable students to reach high academic standards, the school has put in place a dress code designed to reduce distractions and competitions. Implementing a simple, flexible, cost-effective dress code promotes student learning and increased academic instruction time. Interpretation of the Dress Code is at the principal and staff's discretion and their decision is final.

Personal Hygiene

The personal grooming of students should be in accord with the standards set by the uniform dress code. Students should be clean and neat when at school.

All Students

- Students Kindergarten - 5th grade must wear solid bright green, white, solid heather/light grey, or solid powder/light blue-colored shirts that have collars (includes mock turtlenecks, long- or short-sleeved, cotton or knit). A bright green polo purchased only through Image Builders is encouraged. Please contact the Image Builders toll-free customer service hotline at (855) 654-6243. A customer service representative will be available from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday - Eastern Standard Time or go to the school website for more information.
- Middle School students must wear solid bright green, white, solid navy, solid heather/light grey, or solid powder/light blue shirts that have collars (include mock turtlenecks, long- or short-sleeved, cotton or knit). A bright green polo purchased only through Image Builders is encouraged. Please contact the Image Builders toll-free customer service hotline at (855) 654-6243. A customer service representative will be available from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday - Eastern Standard Time or go to the school website for more information.
- Middle school students may also wear a long- or short-sleeve white dress shirt with a navy/bright green tie. Ties purchased only through Image Builders are encouraged.
- All shirts worn under uniform shirts must be solid white.
- Shoes: Students may wear tennis shoes or dress shoes of their choice. Shoes must be closed-toed; croc style shoes, sandals, flip flops, boots, shoes that light up, and wheelies are not permitted; winter boots and rain boots are not permitted to be worn during the school day. If a student wears winter boots or rain boots to school, they must change out of them to appropriate shoes when they enter the classroom.
- Snow boots and rain boots are permitted outside and must be removed when entering the classroom.
- Shoes with wheels or lights are not permitted.
- Solid-colored: sweaters and sweater vests that are navy or white are acceptable. No hoods, stripes, logos, patterns or fur are permitted. All collars of underneath shirts must be visible.
- Sweatshirts, fleece jackets, hoodies, polartec jackets may be worn as outerwear only while students are outside.
- Hats of any kind are not permitted.
- Extreme hairstyles are not permitted. Hair color must be of natural tones and may not be colored, dyed, or streaked.
- No neck jewelry (including key lanyards) or wrist jewelry is permitted other than a watch,
- Belts must be solid black, brown or navy (no ornamental belt buckles).
- Wearing, carrying, and displaying gang paraphernalia, names, signs, or symbols of gang membership are prohibited.
- Visible markings, tattoos, or writings on students are not permitted.
- Bandanas are not permitted.

Boys

- Uniform-style pants or shorts that are navy blue for Kindergarten - 5th grade, khaki or navy blue for Middle School must be worn.
- Belts must be worn with trousers that have belt loops.
- No sagging pants are permitted.
- Shirts must be tucked into pants or shorts at all times.
- White or navy socks must be worn.
- Hairstyles must be conservative.
- Body piercing ornaments are not permitted, including earrings. Any boys coming to school with piercings will be asked to remove them immediately. Band-Aids may not be used to cover the piercings.

Girls

- Uniform-style pants, Capri pants, skirts, skorts, or jumpers that are navy blue for Kindergarten - 5th grade, and khaki or navy blue for Middle School must be worn. All bottoms must be either longer than the fingers when the student's arms hang at her sides or no more than three inches above the knees. No ties on bottoms are permitted.
- White or navy blue socks or tights must be worn. No leggings or footless tights may be worn under skirts or skorts.
- One pair of earrings is permitted. Only ears may be pierced. All earrings must be no larger than one inch in diameter.
- Makeup is not permitted.
- Body piercing ornaments are not permitted.
- No purses are permitted in the classrooms.

Dress Code for Jean Days

- Jeans or regular school uniform must be worn
- Uniform shirt must be worn
- Clothing must be school appropriate (no holes in jeans, no tight or clingy, no low cut tops).
- Sagging pants are not permitted.
- Skulls on clothing are not permitted.
- Jewelry is not permitted.
- Hoods are not permitted.
- Clothing not addressed in this sub-section must adhere to the above dress requirements.

Special Events

- For field trips, the dress code is set by the classroom teacher.
- For Fall Yearbook Picture Day, students must follow the standard dress code.
- For Spring Personal Picture Day, students may follow the standard dress code or wear more formal clothing (e.g., suits or dresses), per parental judgment.
