Sometimes people use their cell as their main number, and it isn't designated as a cell in the system. We have a new parent notification system called SchoolMessenger. This is what Principal Muhammad has been using all school year to send emails and text messages to parents. To receive text messages from us:

This policy is in place as part of our School Improvement Plan. Below are our wellness policy goals:

- 1. Nutritional information for every food item can be found on the Food Service website. The website link shall be included on schools' menus and school website. - 2. Each classroom teacher must promote one youth physical activity from the CDC's "Be Active and Play 60 Minutes Every Day!"
