

Young 5's Supply List

Things to bring each day

- ◇ Backpack - labeled with student's name
- ◇ Morning and afternoon healthy snacks - labeled snack 1 and snack 2, placed in a bag separate from lunch box, please know your child and keep in mind if he/she may need 2 items to snack on at each snack time
- ◇ Lunch (if not purchasing school lunch) - lunch box labeled with student's name
For the first week of school, please send peanut-free items until we can confirm allergies.
You should have received information on how to prepay for hot lunches and milk in an email from the office. If you need more information please contact the front office. Hot lunch will be served on the first day of school.
- ◇ Water Bottle - labeled with student's name

Classroom supplies to bring during the first week

- ◇ Change of clothes—to be left at school in case of spills or accidents, in a Zip-loc bag with your students name on it (underwear, socks, shirt, pants - all labeled)
- ◇ 5 two pocket **plastic** folder WITH holes-one blue, one green, one black, one red, one orange - not labeled
- ◇ 1 1" 3-ring binder - Not labeled
- ◇ 1 pencil box labeled with child's name - the plastic ones are best please
- ◇ 2 or more boxes of washable crayons, NOT the jumbo size
- ◇ 2 packages of 4 or more Expo brand dry erase markers
- ◇ 2 packages of 4 or more fine tip dry erase markers
- ◇ 1 package of Markers of 8 count or more
- ◇ 1 package of 12 or more colored pencils
- ◇ 2 pairs of headphones (Five below has some good cheap options) Labeled with name - these will stay at school and will not travel back and forth to home
- ◇ 1 package of 4 or more hi-lighters
- ◇ 1 Primary lined writing notebooks - Please be sure they are primary lined and not college rule, wide rule, etc...you can get these on Amazon, at Target, Office Max, etc...
- ◇ 1 Channie's brand Big Block Alphabet Blank Writing Pad - Amazon, Target, or Channies.com
- ◇ 1 drawing notebook (blank white paper)
- ◇ 6 containers or more of playdough
- ◇ 1 lanyard with a clear badge holder - we will use this for computer badge logins
- ◇ 6 containers or more of playdough

Other Items

- ◇ For winter, it works best for students to have a pair of boots, snow pants, hat, and a pair of waterproof gloves that stay here at school.
 - ◇ Plug in mouse for the Chromebook (optional)
- DONATIONS**-There will be an additional sign up list for other classroom supplies needed for projects, snacks, band aids, etc...As we get closer to the school year!

Kindergarten Supply List

- 1 - Regular sized backpack (big enough to hold a folder, water bottle, Chromebook, and lunchbox)
 - 1- Headphones or Earbuds that will be labeled and kept at school
 - 1- Gym Shoes that can either be worn to school on the day of gym class or daily.
 - 1- box of Kleenex (any brand is fine)
 - 1 - Water Bottle with child's name written on it with sharpie
 - 1- age appropriate scissors: right or left handed as needed, write child's name on scissors (instead of package) with sharpie
 - 3 - tubs of Clorox wipes (must be Clorox brand)
 - 2 - 8+ ounce bottles of Purell hand sanitizer
 - 2 - boxes of Ticonderoga pencils (pre-sharpened is a bonus and must be Ticonderoga due to our pencil sharpener!)
 - 4 - boxes of 24 count regular size Crayola washable crayons
 - Approx. 12 - Elmer's washable school glue sticks
 - 12 - Expo dry ease markers (we use these A LOT)
 - 1 -pencil/crayon pouch with name written on outside
- An extra set of dress code clothing including shirt, pants, underwear, and socks. Accidents happen☺ Please put the clothes in a labeled zip lock bag and I will store them in the room.

Please pick 2 from list below:

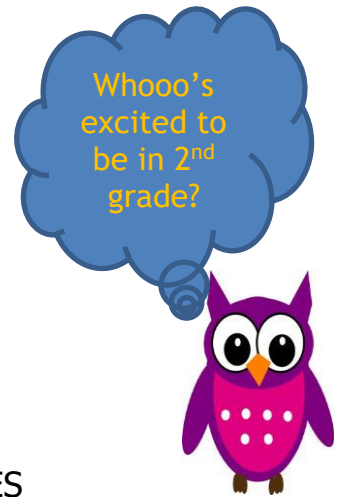
