# Things to bring each day

- ♦ Backpack labeled with students name

- ♦ 2 packages of Markers of 8 count or more

- ♦ 1 pair of headphones (Five below has some good cheap options)
- ♦ 1 package of 4 or more hi-lighters

- ♦ 1 pair uniform tennis shoes, can be worn daily, but must be worn on gym days. Black, White, Navy-see handbook.
- For winter, it works best for students to have a pair of boots, snow pants, hat, and a pair of waterproof gloves that stay here at school. Start looking now at resale shops, hand-me-downs, garage sales, etc. One-piece snowsuits work great so they can hang on their cubby and dry out and still have a dry coat to wear home!


# **Miscellaneous Items:**
