We have found that the quality and durability of these products are best suited for the younger classrooms. Many of the brands listed are offered at deep discounts around August in store flyers. Don't forget to buy supplies for use at home.

- 1 pack of Large Beginner pencils
- Crayola Crayons (4 packs of 24)
- 1 pack of Large Crayola Washable Markers
- 6 Large Elmer's glue sticks (not the small size, please)
- 2 small block Erasers (any color or brand– not giant big mistake erasers, please)
- 2-4 Boxes of tissues
- 1 microfiber cleaning cloth
  - Same price as a roll of paper towels, but I won't need to worry about running out or ask for more halfway through the year :)
  - You find these in the cleaning aisle at any grocery store. They can also be found at Dollar Tree!
- Sandwich size ziplock bags (any brand)
- Gallon size ziplock bags (any brand)
- Pack of 4 Expo brand markers (large size, not fine tip)
- If you have any extra or unmatched socks, we could use them as erasers for whiteboards. (Please make sure they are clean before sending them in)
- 1 pack of paper napkins (pack of 100 or more)
  - Tip: Kroger has packs of 120 for \$0.79 – *Check This Out* brand
- One bottle of hand sanitizer (any size that has a pump)
- One pair of regular child-size scissors
- 1 Wide-Ruled plain spiral notebook
- Watercolor paints with brush (8 colors, with paintbrush - any brand)
  - Tip: Up&Up brand at Target is only \$1.79
- Construction paper
- 1 spray bottle of Method disinfecting cleaner (Labeled AntiBac – scent does not matter, as long as it is the AntiBac).
  - Target has the best selection, but you can find the AntiBac cleaner at most other stores.
  - I prefer to use Method cleaners with young students because of the heavy chemicals that are in Lysol and Clorox cleaners. Method AntiBac cleans just as well, but is easier on sensitive skin.
