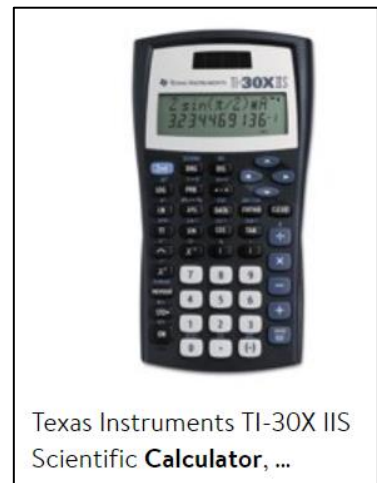


## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

Supply List due by September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019

- Drawstring bag
- 5 composition notebooks—standard 100 sheets, college ruled (one each for: math, ELA, social studies, science, and moral focus)
- 4 Folders (blue, green, red, yellow) with 3-hole punch
- 2-inch, 3 ring white binder/Fabric binder-Labeled with your first and last name on the front**
- 3 ring pencil pouch with a zipper
- Pencils
- Red and black pens
- Lots & lots glue sticks
- Colored pencils, markers, or crayons
- Highlighters
- Expo Markers
- Handheld pencil sharpener
- Pencil Cap Erasers
- Ruler (with inches and centimeters)
- Scissors
- Post-its
- Correction Tape (please no liquid white out)
- Scotch Tape
- 100 (3x5) notecards
- 1 pack of construction paper
- 3 reams of lined paper
- 1 ream of graph paper
- Hand Sanitizer
- Clorox wipes
- Paper towel
- 2-3 tissue boxes
- Deodorant (to keep in lockers, no spray perfume/cologne)

## THE BINDER SYSTEM – A MOBILE HEADQUARTERS

Have you ever...

- Wanted to earn better grades and still have time for extra-curricular activities and socializing?
- Forgotten to do a homework assignment?
- Forgotten certain books, notebooks, or folders at school that you needed for homework?
- Been annoyed as your parents 'nagged' you about homework or studying?
- Brought the wrong folder or notebook to class?
- Misplaced a homework assignment that you knew you did?
- Looked inside your bag to find a sea of randomly stashed papers staring back at you?
- Felt rushed or frustrated getting ready for school in the morning?

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED FOR YOUR BINDER

3-Ring Binder: Let's call it a Mobile Headquarters – A sturdy 2-inch binder with front and back pockets or a fabric binder with a zipper. This binder will have everything you need. Don't go to class without it!

Colored Folders with 3 hole punch: These folders should fit into the binder. The folders are to keep you organized from class to class. Each colored folder will be for a specific class. Blue=Social Studies, Red=ELA, Yellow=Math, Green= Science. Label each folder its class name. Part of your homework time should be spent organizing papers – every paper has a home! Keep only the papers you are currently working on in your binder. After taking chapter/unit tests, store all graded papers at home.

Planner: **mandatory** and provided by TEA for your first copy. Keep this in the front of your Mobile HQ. **Record assignments as the teacher gives them in class.** You will be able to reference back to your planner for your daily/weekly homework. If planner gets lost, it is the students responsibility to replace it (can purchase another one from office for \$5).

Zipper pencil pouch with 3 rings: This will hold pencils, erasers, scissors, red pens, glue sticks, colored pencils or crayons, highlighters, notecards, and correction tape. Keep a light load – **only carry what you need, the extras will stay in your locker.**

Middle school is a BIG change, that comes with more responsibility. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers are asking for you to be prepared for each new day and class. During the school year, you will run out of supplies Ex. Pencils, glue, colored pencils. Please continue to update your supplies throughout the year. It is your responsibility to have these items in each class. Please communicate with your parents/guardians if you run out of a school supply. This is also your responsibility, to let your parents/guardians know what you need for class. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers would greatly appreciate that you come to class prepared and ready to learn. 😊 We are excited to begin the year and we cannot wait to meet the new 6<sup>th</sup> graders. **The Mobile HQ is due September 6<sup>th</sup>.**

## COMMUNITY CLASSROOM SUPPLIES: Give to homeroom teacher

- 1 Pack of College Ruled Loose-leaf Paper
- 1 Box of #2 Pencils
- 3 Containers of Clorox Wipes
- 3 Boxes of Tissue
- 4 Glue Sticks
- 1 Pack of Expo Markers
- 1 Pack of Index Cards
- 1 Bottle of Hand Sanitizer
- 1 Pack of Pencil-top Erasers
- 1 Roll of Paper Towel
- 1 box of Gallon/Sandwich size bags

## STUDENT CLASSROOM SUPPLIES: Student keeps these items with them

- Drawstring bag\*\* (*students are not allowed to carry any bags, backpacks, or purses, EXCEPT for a drawstring bag*)
- 1 set of headphones/earbuds to be used during Science class\*\*
- 1 Composition Notebook for MORAL FOCUS (college ruled)\*\*
- 1 3-Ring Binder with loose-leaf paper for SOCIAL STUDIES\*\*
- 3 3-Subject Notebooks (1 for MATH, ELA and SCIENCE)\*\*
- 4 Folders with Pockets\*\*
- 2 Boxes of #2 Pencils\*\*
- 6 Multi-Colored Highlighters\*\*
- 1 Pair of Adult Size Scissors\*\*
- 4 Glue Sticks\*\*
- 1 Handheld Pencil Sharpener
- 1 Box Colored Pencils
- 1 Pencil Case/Pouch
- 1 Box Black/Blue/Red Pens
- 1 Calculator (TI-30XII will be used in the classroom)

# **Eighth Grade Supply List**

Supplies are due the second day of school

## **Homeroom**

- 500 sheets of loose-leaf lined paper (college rule)
- 4 boxes of Kleenex
- 2 containers of Clorox (or similar) cleaning wipes
- 2 rolls of paper towel
- 1 large or 2 small bottles of hand sanitizer
- Composition or Spiral Notebook for Moral Focus
- Drawstring bag **\*\*students are not allowed to carry any bags, backpacks, or purses from class to class, EXCEPT for a drawstring bag.**

## **ELA**

- **1 3-subject notebook (should be at least 120 pages)**
- 1 bottle of glue (not sticks)
- Enough blue or black pens to get through the year
- 1 red pen
- Highlighters of 4 different colors (helpful, not required)

## **Math**

- 1 college-ruled notebook (spiral or composition) at least 100 pages
- Enough # 2 pencils to get through the school year
- Red pens for correcting homework
- Colored pencils (helpful, but not required)
- Ruler (helpful, but not required)
- TI-30 Calculator (helpful, but not required)

## **Social Studies**

- A 1.5 inch binder (preferably with a clear cover pocket, any color)
- 500 sheets of loose leaf lined paper
- Enough pencils, or blue/black pens to get through the year
- Colored pencils (helpful, but not required)
- 3 different colored highlighters (helpful, but not required)

## **Science**

- 3-subject notebook
- Headphones/Earbuds
