2 packages of disinfectant wipes

1 pair of gym shoes to be used for Physical Education

1 shirt for Art class - an old adult T-shirt works fantastic.

Please do not purchase a pencil box. All supplies will be put in to a community basket where students will share.

Triumph Academy Kindergarten Supply List Mrs. Gardner's Class 2019/2020

Welcome to the 2017-2018 school year. I am so excited to begin helping your child learn and grow. The following is a <u>suggested list</u> of school supplies your child will need for their kindergarten year. While I would like everyone to supply them, I do not want to create undue stress on any family. If purchasing the items causes an unrealistic financial burden, please contact me and I will find a way to accommodate the situation. I want every child to succeed!

1 School Back Pack with <u>no</u> wheels please. Please make sure a regular size folder will fit inside it and it will zip easily.

Crayons – please purchase at least a 24-count box of crayons. If your child wants a bigger box that is fine too.

1 pair of Fiskars or any other kind metal blade scissors - no plastic blades

1 two-pocket folder – to be brought to school and sent home with daily work in it.

1 bottle of Elmer's White School Glue

6 to 8 small glue sticks or several large ones

Several sharpened pencils

- 3 white board markers black Expo brand markers only NO red they don't erase and will be sent back home.
- 3 boxes sandwich or snack-size zipper bags we use these for our daily snack
- 1 boxes of facial tissues
- 1 packages of antibacterial wipes we use these to wipe off the tables every day. That said I usually have the room with the lowest absent report due to illness each year.

5 packages of baby wipes - we use these for everything and go through a lot of them. We usually have to ask for more towards the end of the year.

3, boxes, bags, or containers of dry snacks to share with the class for snack time. (Examples include vanilla

wafers, graham crackers, fish crackers, pretzels, any kind of dry cereal, etc. I will put a note in my weekly newsletter when our snack cupboard is getting low. If you would like to send in cut up vegetables or fruit please make sure it is properly washed and cut up. We will serve it the day it arrives on small plates or napkins for the students to choose from. Other wise we will bag up several selections at a time for our snack bin and your child can choose a snack for snack time from our bin each day.

4 packages of small paper or plastic cups (To help make snack time as easy as possible, the children get their water in these cups), bathroom 4 oz. size is great. If you can purchase plain cups or cups of just one design, without favorite characters on them it helps prevent cups from being dug through to find favorites. This saves us time and helps us from wasting cups because they end up all over and on the floor from being dug through. Thank you.

1 pair of gym shoes to be used for physical education class they don't have to be new. OR they may wear their gym shoes to school on the designated physical education day. You will just have to remember which day P.E. falls on each week.

1 shirt for art class – an old <u>adult</u> T-shirt works fantastic – please put your child's name on or in it. Several K students last year had decorated theirs before bringing them in.

Please make sure your child's supplies are marked with their name in permanent ink, especially their shoes, and art shirt.

<u>Do Not</u> purchase a school supply box or pencil box. <u>I will be providing</u> each student with a supply box to keep all of their own supplies in. Having their own supplies and box keeps the germs from spreading in the classroom as well.

<u>Do Not</u> send in colored markers or colored pencils. I have a classroom supply that we will use on specific projects throughout the year.

I will be giving your child one or two of each of the items where I have asked for a numerous amount. I will collect the extras and then give them to your child as they need new supplies. Once an item is depleted from their supply, such as glue sticks, I will send a note home asking for you to send in more.

We will use all these things in our classroom and most of the items are used daily in K. We do promote using items wisely so we don't waste.

Triumph Academy Kindergarten Supply List Mrs. Jordan's Class 2019-2020



Welcome to Triumph Academy and welcome to our class! I am honored that you are entrusting me with your child and their education this year. We have a year full of learning ahead of us! In order to learn and grow, your child will need the following school supplies. If there is a serious financial burden, please contact me and I will do my best to assist you.

- 1 school backpack with <u>no</u> wheels please. A regular sized folder should easily fit when the backpack is zipped.
- \circ 4 24 pack of crayons
- 2 10 pack markers
- 1 pair of metal blade scissors
- o 4 two-pocket plastic folders with prongs in the following colors: red, green, blue, yellow
- o 1 pack of 8.5" x 11" white cardstock
- 2 bottles of white or clear school glue (please no colored or glitter glue)
- o 6-8 small glue sticks or 3-4 large ones (again, no glitter glue)
- 24 pencils (yellow only please as these will be collected and used for community supplies)
- 4 dry erase white board markers <u>black only</u> (other colors will be sent home)
- 2 primary composition journals (similar to the one below, primary composition journals have large lines for beginning writers)



- 1 box of facial tissue
- o 1 package of antibacterial wipes Lysol, Clorox, etc. (we use these to wipe down tables every day)
- o 1 pack of baby wipes (for lunch time clean up and any spills and messes throughout the day)
- 1 pair of gym shoes can be old tennis shoes and may be worn on PE day, you'll just have to remember which day PE falls on
- o 1 art shirt (Old adult shirts work great! Please put your child's name in it.)
- 1 plastic water bottle with a pop top or pull top to be brought to school on Monday and taken home on Friday for washing – used daily (please no bottles where the child has to unscrew the lid)
 - *** No pencil box is needed. One will be provided.

Please make sure that you label all of your child's school supplies with a permanent marker. Where multiples have been asked for, your child will be given one or two to use and they will be resupplied with their labeled supplies when they run out. After all of it is used, a note will be sent home asking for more. Please note that most of the above supplies will be used on a daily basis, however we try to teach supply responsibility in an effort to avoid waste.




